




A Scene is basically used to combine/ trigger various actions via just a single command.



Access the Main Control
Panel from the Main
Screen – Tap on the
Scenes section of the
Control Panel.


Tap the 'Create New Scene' section and proceed.






Select the 'Scene Name' accordingly from a variety of options (In this example, the Scene Name has been selected as 'Good Morning').


Select the Area / Room where you'd prefer to trigger the necessary action.





Select the Device you'd like to trigger as part of the Scene, from devices you've already added to the room.

In this scenario we've selected the 'Ceiling Light' to be part of the Scene here (Upon triggering 'Good Morning' – the 'Ceiling Light' is expected to turn on.






The Final State of the Device as part of the Scene can be set and saved accordingly.

Save the Device/Device
State as part of the
Scene and then
proceed. On this Screen,
you may either choose to
finalize the Scene itself or
proceed to Add more
Devices to the Scene by
tapping the 'Add More
Devices' section at the
Bottom Left Corner.



Upon tapping 'Add More Devices', you are given the Option to again select the room for your targeted action which will be triggered as part of the scene. You can either go setup more devices in the same room or select a new room as well.

We've decided to go
with the Air-Conditioning
Unit in this scenario. The
Actions to be carried are
to be input before
proceeding.





In this Scenario, we've opted to turn off the Airconditioning Unit upon triggering the 'Good Morning' scene. You can save the Device/Device State when the desired action has been configured as needed.

Once the necessary Devices and their respective actions have been saved as part of the Scene itself, you can either proceed to confirm the Scene as a whole or proceed to add further devices as need be. Upon completion, all you have to do tap the 'Done' section on the Screen and your Scene is good to go.





The Screen will now display a summary of the Scene and the actions to be triggered under the same. All you have to do is 'Save' and proceed.
